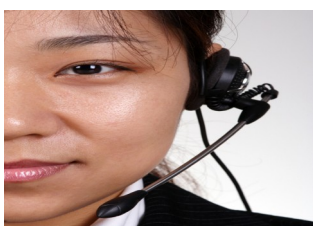

University Preparation College (UPC) is an Australian Government recognised college for teaching English and Vocational courses to both Australian and overseas students. The UPC courses can be packaged for entry to many Australian universities and advanced colleges.



ENGLISH STUDIES

UPC provides a wide range of English courses from beginning to advanced level. We prepare English skills for overseas students who want to enter universities, advanced colleges or the Australian workforce.

There are four basic programs:

- (1) **English for Pre-Foundation Studies** - Teaching general English from beginning to intermediate level;
- (2) **English for Academic Purpose** - Preparing students for university or advanced college;
- (3) **English for Specific Purposes** - Specialising in 3 programs: Science, Technology and Business and
- (4) **Preparation for IELTS** - Providing training to students who want to proceed directly to university or vocational programs or who want to enter the Australian workforce through permanent residential status.

The English courses can be packaged for entry to many Australian universities and colleges.

ACCOUNTING

Diploma of Accounting (FNS50204) CRICOS 062084M
Certificate III in Accounting (FNS30304) CRICOS 062083A

You will spend the first 6 months on the Certificate 3 program and another 6 months to complete the Diploma. The Accounting program is designed for people who intend to work in accounting and seek professional identification in Australia through one of the professional accounting bodies.

The course covers skills and knowledge required to operate account systems in a range of businesses up to complex corporate financial management.

UPC graduates with good grades can articulate to a university degree.

CHILDCARE

Diploma of Children's Services (CHC50908) CRICOS 071623C
(Early Childhood Education and Care)
Certificate III in Children's Services (CHC30708) CRICOS 071619K

These childcare qualifications delivered over 18 months (6-month Certificate III & 12-month Diploma) are designed for both Australian and overseas students. You must have an interest in child development but you are not expected to have previous experience in childcare.

The Diploma course covers childcare and centre management. You study child development, behaviour management, staff support, working with parents and the community, centre management and leadership.

The Program has over 420 hours of work placement which qualifies you as a childcare worker, childcare program, group or team leader, childcare centre manager and childcare co-ordinator.

UPC graduates with good grades can articulate to a university degree.

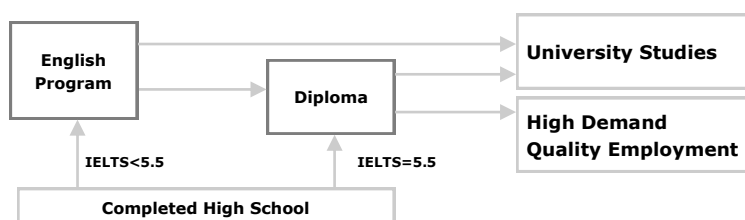
INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Diploma of IT (Networking) (ICA50405) CRICOS 062088G
Cert IV in IT (Networking) (ICA40405) CRICOS Code 062087G
Certificate II in IT (ICA20105) CRICOS Code 062086J

You have to complete the Certificate 2 in IT before taking on the Certificate 4 in IT (Networking) or the Diploma of IT (Networking). The Diploma course covers skills and knowledge in high level LAN and WAN network design, installation and system management.

This is an area of high demand for skilled people in Australia and overseas. UPC graduates with good grades can articulate to a university degree.

VET programs: 1 Term = 9 weeks (or 10 weeks for Diploma of Children's Services) of study = 3 months (total times)

Entry Requirements for Diploma Programs

Entry for Overseas students - Higher School Certificate (HSC) or equivalent.

English Language Proficiency - Students should have an English proficiency of at least 5.5 on IELTS score or equivalent. If English level is less than 5.5, students are required to take 10 weeks of English for every 0.5 score of the IELTS. For example, if a student's English level is 4.5 IELTS score (or equivalent), he or she has to study at least 20 weeks of English at UPC before entering the vocational program.

Recognition of Prior Learning is available if students have studied or worked in related services areas.

Timetable

English: Twenty hours per week. Morning or Afternoon shift.

Accounting & Information Technology: Twenty hours per week. Computer lab practical is compulsory.

Children Services: Three days per week including work placements.

Course structure

Courses are 4 terms a year and 9 weeks (Accounting & IT) and 10 weeks (English & Children's Services) per term. There is a combination of classroom lectures & practical and work experience (Children's Services Program) .

Assessment

Assessments for Vocational Programs are competency based which means you complete written knowledge exercises, exams, practical skill. UPC results show subjects with grade marking to support students wanting credit at university.

Materials

Textbooks are on loan from the College and extra notes are supplied. If textbooks are required, a loan deposit of \$40 is charged per book at the start of the course. Students provide their own writing materials. There is computer access and a library.
